

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The school reserves the right to change and adapt the program, to form groups and to close registration to classes once they are full.
2. Priority is given to those who register early, receive a confirmation and pay for classes.
3. A level classes are for dance professionals and dance students who have studied dance in a higher education institution for 3 years and more. B level classes require contemporary or classic dance experience of at least 2 years.
4. Teacher has a right to transfer a student to another level after the first class.
5. School reserves the right to film and/or to photograph classes without asking for participant's permission or entitling him/her to compensation. The activity of participants in classes can be filmed/ photographed using audio or video equipment and transmitted, disseminated or broadcast publicly in order to publicize or document the school.
6. Participants are not allowed to film and to photograph the classes.
7. Participants can withdraw or change the classes only on the first day and upon agreement of school administration as well as the teacher.
8. Money paid for classes can be returned to the participant only after a medical confirmation proving participant's inability to attend the class, is presented.
9. Participants have to sign attendance sheets every day while attending the classes. If a participant is late for the class for more than 5 minutes, school staff have a right to ask him/ her to leave.
10. Only the participants who have attended the whole course are entitled to receive school certificates.
11. Participants have to keep clean and neat surroundings, avoid making noise and avoid disturbing the order in classes.
12. School staff do not take responsibility for the belongings left in changing rooms or elsewhere in school premises. We highly recommend keeping valuable possessions in the classrooms rather than leaving them in changing rooms.
13. School staff do not take responsibility for injuries and other health problems occurring during the classes. Participants enter the classes at their own risk and are responsible for their own health. They must inform teachers about their health problems if any.
14. Summer Dance School staff do not provide parking and car security services.
15. If participants fail to comply with the regulations set by School, they may be expelled from classes without refunding the money paid.
